This is a letter about the Stewardship Drive. Each year we have a tradition of asking for pledges during a special Sunday celebration after church.

You are invited to participate with us in this tradition, if you feel moved to do so. Unitarian congregations are self supporting communities, who value both independence and responsibility. Financial contributions support the rental of Sapperton Hall for Sunday services, the work of the staff (including the Minister, the Religious Education teachers, the Sound Technician, the Choir Director, the Accompanist, and our administrative costs).

We ask our members and supporters to pledge a monetary amount, although stewardship is not only about the money. It's about taking care of something you value and enabling it to grow; it's about creating and maintaining a healthy, vibrant congregation.

The Beacon Board of Trustees has identified some hopes and dreams for 2015 that represent a change from the current budget:

- 1. Improving the Religious Education space
- 2. Upgrading the infant quiet space in our sanctuary
- 3. A cost-of-living raise for our staff
- 4. Sustaining the Minister's <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> time contract

This year, our Stewardship Drive will begin on Sunday October 19<sup>th</sup> with a special congregational cupcake celebratory launch where you can fill in your pledge card and chose the financial amount you wish to give.

If you are not able to complete your pledge card at that time you may bring it to church on the following two Sundays or put it in the mail.
